Penn Vet was pleased to present the 113th Penn Annual Conference - one of the largest annual gatherings of veterinary colleagues, alumni, friends and clients in the Philadelphia region. The 2013 Conference focused on surgery and offered the opportunity for attendees to gain knowledge on this very significant component of veterinary medicine. Several other topics were discussed throughout the two-day conference, including dermatology; equine, exotic animal, and food animal medicine; cardiology; endocrinology; orthopedics; and vet tech issues. In addition to the lectures, a third day of educational sessions offered several hands-on wet labs on topics including extracapsular lateral suture repair, intro-oral nerve blocks, cytology, and tooth extraction.
