

Bulletins et Mémoires de la Société de Anthropologie de Paris, N.S. 1 (#3-4), a special number entitled "Histoire de l'anthropologie: Hommes, idées, moments," prepared under the editorial direction of Claude Blanckaert, A. Ducros, and J.-J. Hublin, contains the proceedings of a colloquium organized by the Société in June of 1989. Articles include two by Blanckaert ("L'Anthropologie en France, le mot et l'histoire, xvie-xixè siècle," and "L'indice céphalique et l'ethnogénie européenne, 1840-1870), Jean Jamin's essay on Paul Rivet, as well as a number of other essays on topics in biological anthropology: the anthropology of Taliamed (C. Cohen), Buffon and Jefferson (J. Roger), the orang-outan downgraded (G. Barsanti), French thought on human origins from Lamarck to Darwin (G. Laurant), antediluvian man (J. Pautrat), genuine and fake fossil men (J. Hublin), cranial and skeletal series (N. Dias), Mortillet's review L'Homme (N. Richard), the Berber paradigm (G. Boetsche and J. Ferrié), Marcellin Boule (J. Piveteau) and the history of paleoethology (A. & J. Ducros).

GradHiva--Volume 8 (1990) includes, among others, essays by Noël Barbe on "'Ethnographie' et révolution: Lequinio de Kerblay (Sarzeau 1755-Newport 1813) et le Jura," by Michel Izard on "L'Indien de Volney," by Francois Sigaut, "De la technologie à l'évolution: L'oeuvre de Pitt Rivers," and by Claude Blanckaert on Boucher de Perthes. Volume 9 (1991) includes material on Michel Leiris, as well as essays by Francine Markovits and André Pessel, "Eléments pour une histoire de l'anthropologie, de la Renaissance au XVIIIè siècle," by Sandra Puccini on the "Institutionalisation de l'anthropologie italienne au XIXè siècle," and by Nathalie Richard on the practice of prehistoric archeology in the nineteenth century, as revealed in museum correspondence.

Journal of the History of Collections--among "recent articles" in this publication of the Oxford University Press (now in its third volume) is Ezio Bassani and Letizia Tedeschi, "The Image of the Hottentot in the Seventeenth and Eighteenth Centuries."
